Background

In June 2017, Lloydminster City Council and Administration began developing a set of goals and strategies to support Council in updating its 2018-2021 Strategic Plan. Through a series of workshops, the following eight key priorities emerged:

- Engage with staff and residents
- Create and maintain a full suite of governance policies
- Create strong fiscal policy related to reserves
- Create, update and budget for a priority-ranked list of capital projects
- Create, modify or rescind human resource policies as required
- Provide guidance for economic development within the City
- Determine a funding model for upgrades to the wastewater treatment plant
- Determine the most appropriate model for management and sale of City-owned land
