## 4.1. Lloyd Mural Festival 2025

Brandi Hofer and Amy Roper presented their proposal for Lloyd Mural Fest and requested financial, volunteer recruitment and organization, and administrative support. Financials are yet to be finalized, however the first year would be centered on parking barriers as a pilot event. The following year would expand with murals at the Harty Developments Skate Park. A finalized budget was requested from the PAAC at the next meeting.

#### 4.2. BAC Artwork:

Issue EOI by the end of January, keep open for 30 days, meet in March to review concept proposals and select artists/sculpture. Install in August/September during BAC shutdown

## 4.3. Public Art Policy Review:

PAAC requires guidance on maintenance requirement within the policy; the Public Art

Reserve does not have the budget to be responsible for maintenance. Making facility operators responsible for maintenance would lead to potential resistance to having art in their facility.

Discussion surrounding the removal of logos within the policy as the PAAC cannot fund anything with corporate branding. Colleen suggested that while artwork can depict a logo, it should not consist of the artwork itself.
