

Health Care Cards

All new Alberta or Saskatchewan residents must register themselves and their dependents for a Health Card in order to receive health services coverage. There are no premiums or payments to be registered with either provincial health care insurance program or to receive a health care card. Any health care card can be used on both sides of the provincial border.



BI-PROVINCIAL CHARACTERISTICS

Time

Daylight Savings Time is a way of making better use of the daylight in the evenings by setting the clocks forward one hour during the longer days of summer, and back again in the fall.

Lloydminster follows the province of Alberta's time format; from Spring to Fall, Alberta follows Mountain Daylight Time (MDT) and from Fall to Spring it follows Mountain Standard Time (MDT).

Saskatchewan is the only Canadian province that does not observe daylight saving time. Since Lloydminster follows Alberta time, this means that for a large portion of the year Saskatchewan slips out of sync with Lloydminster. To help avoid confusion the Alberta time zone extends as far east as Maidstone, Sask.

Provincial Sales Tax (PST)

Provincial Sales Tax (PST) is a six per cent sales tax that applies to taxable goods and services consumed or used in Saskatchewan. It applies to goods and services purchased in the province as well as goods and services imported for consumption or use in Saskatchewan. However, businesses located within the city limits of Lloydminster, Saskatchewan are not required to account for PST.



WEATHER AND CLIMATE

Lloydminster experiences a continental climate characterized by distinct seasonal variations, including cold winters and warm summers.

Lloydminster also experiences varying wind patterns, influenced by the open landscapes of the prairies. The wind direction predominantly comes from the west or northwest, with seasonal variations affecting its intensity and temperature. In winter, winds can be particularly biting and severe, often contributing to wind chill factors that make the air feel colder than the actual temperature. These wind patterns are a significant aspect of Lloydminster's climate, shaping the overall weather experience throughout the year.

WINTERS in Lloydminster are marked by frigid temperatures, often dropping well below freezing. Average winter temperatures frequently reach -20°C (-4°F) or lower, creating a brisk and chilly environment.

SUMMERS in Lloydminster are relatively short but can be quite warm. During this season, temperatures often rise to between 25°C (77°F) and 30°C (86°F), providing a comfortable and pleasant atmosphere for outdoor activities.

SPRING AND FALL bring mild weather, with temperatures typically ranging from 5°C to 15°C (41°F to 59°F).
