

LLOYDMINSTER'S OFF-LEASH DOG PARK

Use of the Off-Leash Dog Park is at Your Own Risk

The City of Lloydminster is not responsible for the safety of persons and/or dogs while in Lloydminster's Off-Leash Dog Park and shall not be liable to anyone for any injuries or damage suffered by any person or dog while in the Park. By entering Lloydminster's Off-Leash Dog Park you are acknowledging and agreeing to abide by the rules set out below.

GENERAL RULES FOR EVERYONE'S SAFETY:

- Children between the ages of 8–15 must be accompanied by an adult
- Refrain from bringing children under the age of 8
- No glass containers
- No dog or human food/treats

TO USE THE DOG PARK, DOGS:

- Must be
 - > licensed (Bylaw 17-2015) and vaccinated
 - > spayed or neutered
 - > accompanied by a handler (16+ years of age)
 - > older than four months
- Must not be
 - > Sick
 - > Aggressive or anti-social
 - > Fearful of other dogs

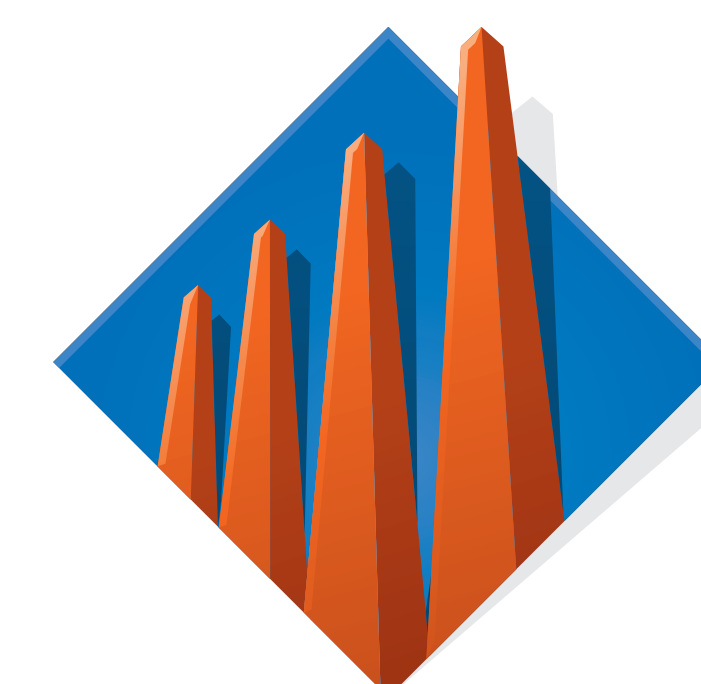
MAINTENANCE:

The park is scheduled to be maintained every second week, weather permitting. The park will be closed during maintenance for the safety of the animals.

TO USE THE DOG PARK, HANDLERS SHOULD:

- Encourage calm and controlled behaviour of your dog(s) prior to entering the off-leash area
- Have voice control over your dog(s)
- Keep your dog(s) within your sight
- Clean up your dog's waste
- Fill holes dug by your dog(s)
- Carry a leash at all times
- Leash the dog while entering/exiting the park (in leashing areas)
- Remove your dog immediately if he/she becomes aggressive
- Only have a max of three dogs off leash at one time
- Bring water for your dog(s)
