

COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

Monday, February 2, 2026

Corporate Services

1. Council approved the operating and capital carryforward projects as listed in Appendix 'A', to be added to the 2026 budget for the combined total of \$35,000,275. Additionally, Council authorized the City Manager or delegate to amend the amounts subject to audit adjustments.

Community Development Services

1. Council approved the following recommended Saskatchewan Lotteries Community Grant Allocations totaling \$86,454 and authorized the Community Services Advisory Committee to reallocate any unused or returned grant funds:
